



## Observation Guidelines

### 1. Choose an observation Area

Find a 1-meter square area containing blooming flowers to make your observation within. Flowers grow all over the place so your observation could take place just about anywhere.

### 2. Observe One Type of Flower

During an observation you will be counting the number of times you see a pollinator land on one type of flower. So before you start an observation you must indicate the type of flower you're observing by photographing it and adding a name/description.

### 3. Count Pollinators

An observation lasts 5 minutes long. During this time, tap the pollinator icons in the app to record each pollinator that lands on the flower you specified. Try not to count the same insect more than once but don't worry about being perfect!

### 4. View Pollinator Details

If you are having difficulty identifying a pollinator you see, click the information (i) icon to view more detailed information.

### 5. Observation Details

Once the 5-minute timer is up, you can stop counting pollinators and add some final details to complete your observation.
