Project Wingspan Ontario: Toronto Seed Collection Workshop

Project Wingspan Ontario engages individuals and communities to participate in native seed collection and pollinator habitat enhancement. Through this workshop, participants will learn about plants important to the monarch and other pollinators and how to collect seed from them using best management practices. There will also be a hands-on component, where participants will have the opportunity to process common milkweed (*Asclepias syriaca*) and wild bergamot (*Monarda fistulosa*) seeds from start to finish.
